JUSTICE AND PEACE are holding a vigil of prayer for refugees outside Downing Street on June 21st 12.30 - 2.30, where there will be a commemoration of those who have died trying to reach places of safety. There is also a Pilgrimage service in the Church of Notre Dame de France, Leicester place, off Leicester Square, to pray for refugees, using a 'Lampedusa Cross', that is a cross which has been made by an island carpenter from one of the refugee boats from Africa. This will take place on Saturday 25th June from 2.30 - 3.30pm. All are welcome.

MARY'S MEALS is a charity that provides one good meal a day in a place of learning to the worlds poorest children. They will be holding a 'Rags to Riches' collection day here on 29th MAY AFTER THE 9.30AM AND 11AM MASSES.. Donations of old clothes, not pillows or duvets please, are requested to be brought in on this morning for collection by the charity volunteers who will be there to receive them from you.

PILGRIMAGE TO WALSINGHAM - SATURDAY 9TH

JULY - Join Cardinal Vincent on the diocesan pilgrimage to Walsingham, England's Nazareth, on Saturday 9th July.
