LENTEN REFLECTIONS AND STATIONS OF THE CROSS:

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, 5th March. There will be two Masses that day at 10am and 7pm. During Lent we will have a series of 7 reflection sessions at either 10.30am, after morning Mass or at 6.30pm followed by Stations of the Cross at 7pm. The first of these sessions will be on Friday 7th March. The six remaining sessions will be weekly on a Wednesday from Wednesday 12th March until Wednesday 16th April inclusive. The theme of these sessions will be 'the last 7 sayings of Jesus'. All are welcome to join in these sessions. Please note that morning and evening sessions have the same content and therefore you can choose the time of day you wish to attend each weekly session and also the number of sessions you wish to attend.

PARISH LENTEN RETREAT:

On Saturday 22nd March we will be hosting the Parish Lenten Retreat from 11.30am-3pm. The day will start with Mass at 11.30 am followed by the first session in the Church until 1pm. Lunch will be from 1pm to 1.30pm. Parishioners are asked to bring a packed lunch. The second session will begin at 1.30pm in the Parish Hall and the day will end at 3pm. All are welcome.
