REGISTRATION FOR CONFIRMATION AND FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2026-27: Enrolment forms for next year's First Holy Communion programme for Children in Year 3 and above and Confirmation programme for children in Year 9 and above are available online from Sunday 19th July - Sunday 27th September 2026.

- To enrol for the Confirmation course please visit <https://stpetersnewbarnet.org.uk/sacraments/confirmation/>. The fee is £130. The parents first meeting for the Confirmation course will be on **Wednesday 14th of October** in the Parish Hall.

All fees must be paid in advance of the commencement of the courses which will be towards the end of September. Please visit the Parish Office to complete your registration by paying the fees.

ADULT SACRAMENTS: Our programme for adults interested in finding out more about the Catholic faith will start soon. The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) programme provides an opportunity to understand the Catholic faith and to prepare for the sacraments of baptism, confirmation and holy communion. The first phase of the programme is focussed on finding out more about our faith and is open to all, without any need for commitment at this stage. The programme will run through to Easter 2027 and is usually on a Sunday evening.
